Student's Cars

In essence the school does not consider that any student needs to use a car to travel to and from the campus. However, we do accept that such transportation is a great convenience, and that most students will use this facility in a mature and responsible manner. However, this is a privilege, which, if abused, will be revoked. Students must be sensitive to the fact that the loss of this privilege may cause great inconvenience to their family.

- **Permits:** During the school day you cannot park a car on campus without a permit. The permit must be displayed clearly on the rear view mirror whilst the car is parked. If you change cars you should transfer the permit and inform us of the new car's details. If you bring a different car in an emergency situation just display your permit in this car and put a note with your name on the dash. The school reserves the right to tow away (at the owners expense), clamp or put warning notices on any car parked without an appropriate permit.
- **Parking:** Your car must be parked in the allocated space. If you arrive and find your space occupied then you must inform Mr. Powell immediately. Cars and student parking lots are strictly out of bounds during the school day. A pass from the Dean of Students or Principal is needed to visit your car.
- **Driving on or near Campus:** If you are reported driving in an unsafe or inconsiderate manor on campus, or on your journey to and from campus, you will be stopped from bringing a car onto campus. In particular:
 - Observe the campus speed limit of 15 mph.
 - Do not carry passengers other than in the seats of your vehicle.
 - Do not carry more passengers than your vehicle's stated capacity.
 - Keep to the paved roads only, do not pull onto the grass to avoid traffic.
 - Only leave and enter the campus by the main entrances.

The privilege to drive and park on campus will be removed for the remainder of a trimester once the student has accumulated any of the following: 6 or more tardies to school (excused or unexcused), 8 or more absences, 5 or more conditionals, 3 or more Saturday detentions or days of suspension.

There is no longer the facility for a student to get parental permission for dismissal via telephone. To get dismissed during the school day the student can be signed out by the parent in person, or provide a note signed by the parent who is requesting the dismissal. This note must contain a specific time, reason for dismissal and a daytime contact telephone number for verification.

The main parking control device is adhesive stickers. Removal of these stickers is not the responsibility of the school. Once 3 stickers have been placed on any one vehicle, parking privileges will be lost for the remainder of the school year.

No refunds will be issued if parking privileges are lost.
